The current keyboard layout is attached for your review and comment. Please try to get your comments back on this pass by August 14. The following notes apply:

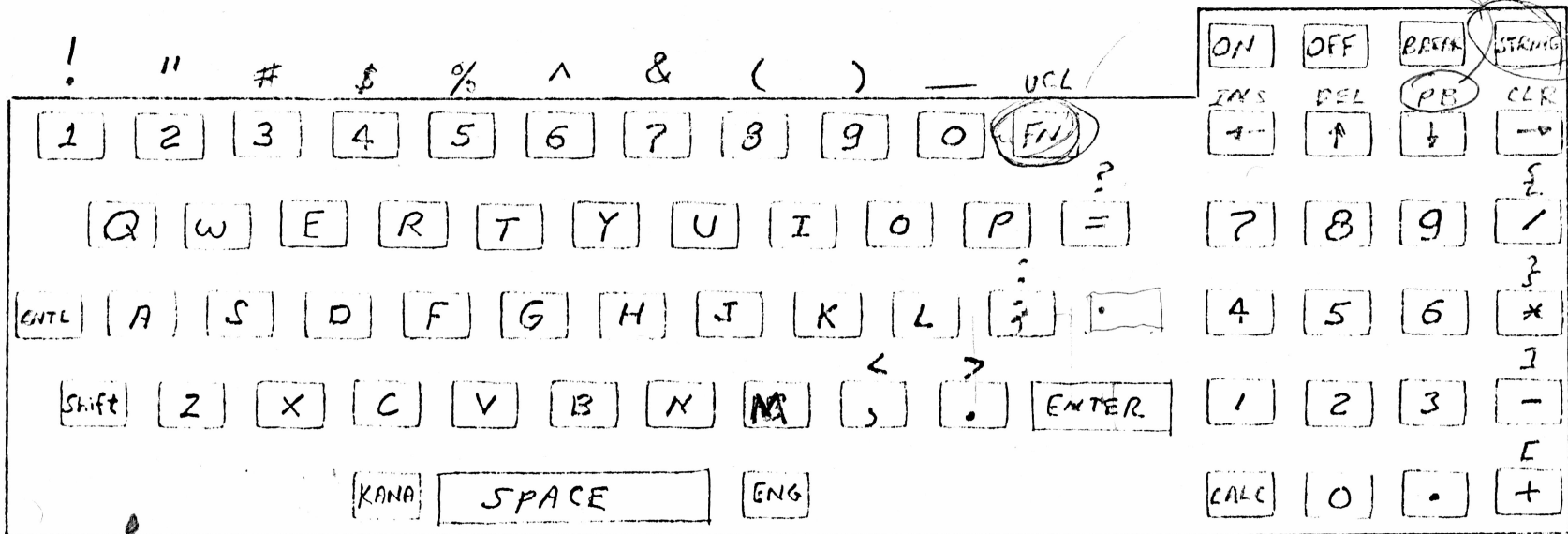
1. UCL stands for upper case lock and is accessed by pressing SHIFT and FN. An indicator in the display shows the UCL mode.
2. { } [] would not actually be printed on the keyboard to reduce clutter.
3. CNTL is used as on a standard keyboard to generate other key codes.
4. CNTL and SHIFT are not used in combination.
5. FN (name subject to change) is used to invoke execution of named routines as in the Sharp 1211.
6. The KANA and ENG keys will be provided for but not be present on the U.S. product.
7. String recalls a text string assigned to a key (e.g. "SIN").
8. CALC is used to perform immediate calculations and has been added to eliminate modes and the mode key altogether.
