The current keyboard layout is attached for your review and comment. Please try to get your comments back on this pass by August 14. The following notes apply:

- 1. UCL stands for upper case lock and is accessed by pressing SHIFT and FN. An indicator in the display shows the UCL mode.
- 2. the keyboard to reduce clutter.
- 3. CNTL is used as on a standard keyboard to generate other key codes.
- 4. CNTL and SHIFT are not used in combination.
- 5. FN (name subject to change) is used to invoke execution of named routines as in the Sharp 1211.
- 6. The KANA and ENG keys will be provided for but not be present on the U.S. product.
- 7. String recalls a text string assigned to a key (e.g. "SIN").
- 8. CALC is used to perform immediate calculations and has been added to eliminate modes and the mode key altogether.
