FIRST MAKE A BACKUP COPY

CAUTION – your printer may not recognize certain commands in this program set. The programs for printing were developed for the Epson (emulation) mode on a nine pin PANASONIC printer, XP1091.

These programs (ADRENV2PAS, ADRENV4PAS and ADDRESLIST), include REM statements listing the line locations and purposes for the printer commands. These you may change as required for your printer.

BIT IMAGE mode is used here for printing barcodes in the envelope printing programs.

Files of mostly fictitious names and addresses are included for trial runs. (I've left the first one blank except for return address). The purpose for this series is to allow for the occasional printing of names and addresses on either legal or letter size envelopes with Sender's name and address in the upper left corner.

This program is arranged to store up to twenty names and addresses of people and organizations, (Sendees), for whom you can address envelopes. (Note that more than twenty names can be handled by multiple use of this program on several disks with separate files).

The Sendees' data may be entered in any order and will be placed in sorted order (alphabetic or otherwise) before being recorded. (Please note that you are including an extra entry on which to sort). The Sendees' names are numbered, shortened and listed to screen to give printing choices. After printing has started, you may continue as long as you wish to complete your run of envelopes, adding more blank envelopes when needed. Bar coding on envelopes is included in two options. For faster printing use two pass bar coding. Darker result can be had with four pass bar coding.

NOTE:

Brand new ribbons will normally give best results with two pass, while old ribbons will give similar results with four pass.

Sendee envelope line for Address / P.O. Box No. may be used for other purposes with 5 digit bar coding. (9 digit bar codes may be in error). Usually, Military & foreign addresses are not designed to work with bar coding.

Facilities are included to allow for the Sendees' data entries to be revised, replaced or deleted on an individual basis. The Sender entry may be changed or replaced in a similar manner. Additionally, on this disk, using existing data files, is a program, ADDRESLIST, that will list your Sender and Sendee names and addresses on one 8-1/2 X 11 printout.
