I N T R O D U C T I O N

M R . F R O G is three games in one! Letter Hop is a letter recognition game. Rock Hop is a counting game and Frog Race is a game in which you can race against a friend or the computer.

O R D E R O F P L A Y

The game begins with the computer displaying the following:

DO YOU WANT?

- 1 LETTER HOP
- 2 ROCK HOP
- 3 FROG RACE
- 4 END

Press the number you want and then press "ENTER".

L E T T E R H O P

LETTER HOP is a letter recognition game for even the youngest members of the family. Rocks that have letters on them will be displayed across the middle of the screen with a frog sitting on a rock just to the right. The object of the game is to make the frog hop to the rock containing the same letter as the rock at the top of the screen. You do this, by pressing the "space" bar. Press "Enter" when you reach the correct rock. If you are right, a frog at the bottom of the screen will hop to the left one rock. This cycle is continued until the frog at the bottom of the screen makes five hops. Then, the song "Mr. Frog Went a Courtin'" is played and the game is finished.

R O C K H O P

ROCK HOP is a counting game for children somewhat older than the children who play Letter Hop. Four lily pads are displayed across the middle of the screen, with a frog just to their right. The objective of the game is to count how many hops are needed for the frog to hop from one rock to the other. Press any number 1 to 5 and the frog will take that many hops. Each time the frog hops to the other rock the frog at the bottom of the screen will take one hop to the left. When the frog at the bottom of the screen makes five hops the song will play, and the game ends.

F R O G R A C E

FROG RACE is a letter recognition race game, in which you try to get your frog to hop across the screen first. It can be played between two people or one person and the computer. If two people are playing, then the person on the right has the top frog and the person on the left has the bottom frog. Two letters will be displayed near the top of the screen, one on the left and one on the right. The first person to press their letter will get a hop from their frog. If you press the wrong letter the other person's frog will hop. The first frog to reach the rock on the left of the screen is the winner!

If you want to race the computer, your frog is on top and the computer's frog is on the bottom. To begin, choose the letter of difficulty and get ready. A letter will be displayed at the top of the screen, and you must press it within a certain time span. If you succeed your frog will take a hop. If you fail or if you press the wrong letter the computer's frog will take one hop.

NOTE FOR DISK VERSION: The disk version is set up to load in during power up. To play the game after power up type in the following:

OLD DSK1.LOAD
RUN
