At 3:15 on Friday October 28th we were informed by Texas Instruments Consumer Product Division that a decision has been made by them to abandon their Home Computer business effective November 1983. Although the total impact of this decision on the computer user community is not yet known, the International 99/4 Users-Group would like to state our position on this matter of importance.

The International 99/4 Users-Group will continue to support both the hardware and software needs of our members as long as we feel that our services are of value. We are in direct contact with Texas Instruments at the corporate level and will be presenting them with a business plan that will include the continuation, by the IUG, of several customer service functions which only they can provide.

Additionally, IUG plans include acquisition of new hardware and software items from third party sources which will provide greater computing value to our members as well as prolong the obsolescence of their current hardware and software configuration.

I personally believe that the outlook for the 99/4A Home Computer is bright and we will continue to work hard to provide the best possible service to our members.
