Dear User Group,

I would personally like to invite you to our 5th International TI Users Meeting, sponsored this year by the TI Workshop Wiesbaden. Last years meeting in Nijmegen, Netherlands had over 400 people in attendance. This year we expect over 500. We have already received reservations from groups in England, France, Italy, Belgium, Austria, and several other countries. It will be held in Wiesbaden-Erbenheim, which is about 15 miles from Frankfort Airport (and Rhein-Main AFB) on 29 Sept 1990. There is a train that stops at the Frankfort airport and takes you to Wiesbaden. The train costs about 4 dollars. I can also meet you at the airport and transport you wherever you wish to stay.

I'd like to also mention that our NEW Disk Controller is ready and will be available at the fair. It will handle 4 disk drives and format up to DSDD (Quad is forthcoming). The cost is 350 DM (\$212.00 @ 1.65 DM to \$1.00 exchange rate). Our SuperModule II, which is a Gram Simulator that fits into a standard TI cartridge, allows you to dump and run all TI and third-party cartridges from either disk or cassette, will also be available. It also has 8K ram space to use as a supercart. It sells for around \$110.00. There will be alot of other new hardware and software from the European community at the fair.

Would you please pass this information around so we can have a greater distribution about our fair. Hope to see you here on September 29th.
