Dear Ollie,

Many thanks indeed for the review, and all the kind words. Of all the 120+ user groups I have exchanged newsletters with over the last 4+ years, yours is only about the 5th to have published a review of any of my programs. One of the reasons why I don't sell many!

Also, many thanks to the fix for the Gordian Knot. I have incorporated the wrap-around version. I know I ran that program several times in the automatic mode when I tested it, but apparently it never attempted to wander over the edge. I do have to remind myself to test my programs more thoroughly (but I always have another project in mind that I'm anxious to get started on!) And rarely does anybody give me any feedback to alert me to the bugs.

I have been meaning to see if I could improve the Gordian Knot, using a sprite as a tracer, so that it would be possible to enter back onto a line, turn and travel along it, and then turn and leave it again. That would make it possible to design some extremely challenging 3-D mazes which could be dumped to a printer.

However, at the moment I'm trying to get the bugs out of three new projects, which are giving me fits. One is a program to break an Extended Basic program of multiple-statement lines into single-statement lines (and I found that my Decompacter was BADLY bugged!) and add to each line a CALL, using the line number as a parameter, which will display the line number being executed in the corner of the screen without scrolling, or dump it to a printer, and with a CALL KEY option to step through the program line by line. Should be a great debugging tool, if I can get it debugged!

Also working on a very original word game, sort of a cross between Rainbow Squares and Word Search. And have nearly completed a diskfull of music, experimenting with different methods of programming.

I am also thinking of making my public domain software library available, for a very reasonable copying fee. I am already doing this for my own user group, as a fund raiser for the group, but have not had too much response. Seems like most TI users are not willing to spend any money at all on programs. Will enclose a copy of the projected offer, and a sample page of the catalog. Do you think any of your members would be interested?

The 130 programs in the Tigercub catalog have been reduced to \$1.00 each, plus \$1.50 per order (not per program) for the cost of the cassette of disk and packaging and mailing. Minumum order \$10, please. Cassette orders can only be filled until my stock of blank cassettes is exhausted. The Handy Dandy programs and the Color Programming Tutor are no longer available on cassette, as they are too long to load from disk.

The 18 Full Disk collections, consisting of 5 or 6 of my catalog programs in one category, and the rest of the disk filled with a bonus of public domain programs of the same type, have been reduced to \$5.00 each, postpaid, minimum order \$10.

These prices are comparable to what many user groups are charging their own members for public domain programs, or what it would cost to download an equal number of programs from Genie or CompuServe.
