CONSTITUTION

**ARTICLE 1
NAME**

THIS USER'S GROUP SHALL BE KNOWN HENCEFORTH AS "9T9 USER GROUP OF TORONTO" (HEREINAFTER CALLED THE "USER'S GROUP").

**ARTICLE 2
PURPOSES**

- 1) TO ENCOURAGE A GREATER UNDERSTANDING OF THE TEXAS INSTRUMENTS FAMILY OF HOME AND PERSONAL COMPUTERS.
- 2) TO PROMOTE THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION, KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE USER'S GROUP.
- 3) TO PROMOTE A FULL DISCUSSION REGARDING PLANNING AND CONDUCT OF THE ABOVE ACTIVITIES.

**ARTICLE 3
MEMBERSHIP**

- 1) MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE OPEN TO ANY PERSON INTERESTED IN THE PURPOSES OF THE USER'S GROUP PROVIDED THAT THAT PERSON SHALL ADHERE TO THE OPERATING PROCEDURES OF THE USER'S GROUP.
- 2) MEMBERSHIP IN THE USER'S GROUP MAY ONLY BE REVOKED BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY VOTE OF THE EXECUTIVE AND SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF MEMBERS ATTENDING THE NEXT GENERAL MEETING.
- 3) IN THE EVENT THAT A MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE REVOKED, THE UNEARNED DUES WILL BE REFUNDED ON A PRO-RATA BASIS.

**ARTICLE 4
FEES**

- 1) THE DUES FOR FULL AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE EXECUTIVE AT OR BY THE LAST EXECUTIVE MEETING OF THE CALENDAR YEAR SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT AT THE NEXT GENERAL MEETING.
- 2) A FULL MEMBERSHIP SHALL ENTITLE THE MEMBER AND ANY OR ALL MEMBERS OF THAT MEMBER'S IMMEDIATE HOUSEHOLD TO ATTEND ALL GENERAL MEETINGS, TO RECEIVE ALL OR OTHER RELEVANT DOCUMENTS PUBLISHED BY THE USER'S GROUP, TO HAVE FULL ACCESS TO THE GROUP LIBRARY, AND TO VOTE ON APPLICABLE ISSUES PUT BEFORE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE USER'S GROUP.
- 3) AN ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP SHALL CONFER ALL OF THE ABOVE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF VOTING PRIVILEGES AND ATTENDANCE AT GENERAL MEETINGS.

**ARTICLE 5
EXECUTIVE POSITIONS**

- 1) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE USER'S GROUP SHALL BE COMPRISED OF THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS:
 - PRESIDENT
 - VICE PRESIDENT
 - PAST PRESIDENT(S)
 - SECRETARY
 - TREASURER
 - OFFICER AT LARGE

2) THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR ALL EXECUTIVE POSITIONS SHALL BE ONE (1) YEAR.

3) EXECUTIVE OFFICERS' MEETINGS SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONCE PER MONTH PRIOR TO THE GENERAL MEETING OF THAT MONTH. THE PRESIDENT MAY, AT HIS DISCRETION OR AT THE WRITTEN REQUEST OF ANY TWO (2) OFFICERS, CALL SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS.

4) A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS AT A MEETING OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS SHALL CONSIST OF A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS.

5) ANY MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING, OR ANY MEMBER OF THAT MEMBER'S HOUSEHOLD, SHALL BE ELLIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION FOR ELECTION TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

6) ANY EXECUTIVE OFFICER WHO, WITHOUT DUE CAUSE, FAILS TO ATTEND THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS' MEETINGS OR WHO IS JUDGED BY THE REMAINING EXECUTIVE OFFICERS TO BE ACTING OTHER THAN IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE USER'S GROUP MAY BE REMOVED FROM OFFICE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF THE REMAINING OFFICERS.

ARTICLE 6 COMMITTEES

1) STANDING COMMITTEES SHALL BE:

PROGRAM COMMITTEE
MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE
LIBRARY COMMITTEE
EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE
EDUCATION COMMITTEE

2) TEMPORARY COMMITTEES MAY BE DESIGNATED AS REQUIRED BY THE PRESIDENT.

ARTICLE 7 MEETINGS

1) THE ANNUAL MEETING FOR THE ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS SHALL BE HELD DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY.

2) GENERAL MEETINGS SHALL BE HELD ON THE LAST TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH OR ON SUCH OTHER DATE AS MAY BE DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT.

3) A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS SHALL CONSIST OF ONE-HALF (1/2) OF THE ACTIVE MEMBERS PRESENT IN PERSON OR REPRESENTED BY PROXY.

4) AN INDIVIDUAL TO CHAIR A NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT NOT LATER THAN ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL MEETING.

ARTICLE 8 AMENDMENTS

1) THIS CONSTITUTION MAY BE AMENDED BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE ACTIVE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING WHO ARE PRESENT IN PERSON OR REPRESENTED BY PROXY AT ANY REGULAR MEETING, BUT NO AMENDMENT SHALL BE VOTED UPON WITHOUT TWO (2) WEEKS WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING.

OPERATING PROCEDURES

ARTICLE 1

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

1) THE PRESIDENT SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL GENERAL MEETINGS AND ALL EXECUTIVE OFFICERS' MEETINGS OF THE USER'S GROUP AND SHALL PERFORM ALL SUCH DUTIES AS ARE INCIDENTAL TO THE OFFICE AND ARE PROPERLY REQUIRED OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER.

2) THE VICE PRESIDENT SHALL, IN THE ABSENCE OF THE PRESIDENT, EXERCISE ALL OF THE FUNCTIONS OF, AND SHALL BE VESTED WITH ALL THE POWERS OF THE PRESIDENT.

3) THE PAST PRESIDENT(S) SHALL ACT IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND SHALL EXERCISE ANY ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES WHICH SHALL BE DEEMED REASONABLE BY THE REMAINDER OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS AND ACCEPTABLE TO THE INDIVIDUAL. ANY PAST PRESIDENT WHO IS A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF THE USER'S GROUP MAY, AT HIS OWN DISCRETION, ATTEND AND VOTE AT ANY EXECUTIVE OFFICERS' MEETING.

4) THE SECRETARY SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL PAPERS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS, MAKE SUCH REPORTS, AND PERFORM ALL SUCH DUTIES AS ARE INCIDENTAL TO THE OFFICE AND ARE PROPERLY REQUIRED OF THE SECRETARY.

5) THE TREASURER SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL FUNDS OF THE USER'S GROUP, SHALL CONDUCT ITS BANKING BUSINESS, AND SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE. CHEQUES DRAWN BY THE USER'S GROUP SHALL BE SIGNED BY EITHER THE PRESIDENT OR THE TREASURER AND SHALL BE COUNTERSIGNED BY AN ADDITIONAL OFFICER.

6) THE OFFICER AT LARGE SHALL PERFORM THOSE DUTIES THAT MAY BE ASSIGNED TO HIM BY THE PRESIDENT.

ARTICLE 2

COMMITTEES

1) THE PROGRAM COMMITTEE SHALL PROVIDE AN INTERESTING AND VARIED PROGRAM FOR EACH GENERAL MEETING AND SHALL COOPERATE WITH THOSE IN CHARGE OF ANY SOCIAL OR SPECIAL MEETINGS AS MAY BE HELD.

2) THE MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE SHALL DIRECT THE WORK OF SECURING NEW MEMBERS, AND MAINTAINING ACCURATE MEMBERSHIP LISTS AND INTEREST/EQUIPMENT PROFILES, AND SHALL ASSIST THE TREASURER IN THE MECHANICS OF COLLECTING MEMBERSHIP DUES AND ISSUING MEMBERSHIP CARDS.

3) THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL SOFTWARE AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS OWNED BY THE USER'S GROUP. IT SHALL CATALOG AND MAINTAIN THE LIBRARY, DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT CHECK-IN/OUT PROCEDURES AND POLICIES (SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE), AND PROCESS NEW ACQUISITIONS.

IN THE CASE OF GROUP SOFTWARE EXCHANGE, THIS COMMITTEE SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT APPROPRIATE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES (SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE).

4) THE EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL PHYSICAL APPARATA OF THE USER'S GROUP (SUCH AS CONSOLES, PERIPHERALS, ETC.) AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSURING THE AVAILABILITY AND APPROPRIATE EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES OF MEETING PLACES. THIS COMMITTEE SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING FACILITIES FOR SPECIAL-INTEREST GROUPS UNLESS SPECIFICALLY SO DIRECTED BY THE PRESIDENT.

5) THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE EDUCATION OF MEMBERS, INCLUDING THE DISSEMINATION OF LITERATURE AND INFORMATION TO THE MEMBERS OR TO THE PUBLIC AT LARGE.

6) THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT, AFTER DUE CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS, THE CHAIRMAN OF EACH COMMITTEE AND SHALL COOPERATE AS REQUIRED WITH THE CHAIRMAN AND OTHER COMMITTEE MEMBERS TO ENABLE THEM TO FULFILL THEIR FUNCTIONS.

7) THE PRESIDENT SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO APPOINT SUCH TEMPORARY OR SPECIAL COMMITTEES AS MAY BE REQUIRED FROM TIME TO TIME AND MAY BE REQUIRED TO APPOINT SUCH BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY VOTE OF MEMBERS PRESENT OR REPRESENTED BY PROXY AT ANY GENERAL MEETING.

8) ANY COMMITTEE MEMBER WHO, IN THE OPINION OF THE CHAIRMAN, IS DEEMED TO BE ACTING OTHER THAN IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE USER'S GROUP MAY BE REMOVED FROM THAT COMMITTEE BY THE CHAIRMAN, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

9) THE VOTE OF THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF ANY COMMITTEE SHALL BE CONSIDERED THE VOTE OF THE COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE.

10) EACH STANDING COMMITTEE SHALL MEET ON A MONTHLY BASIS OR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN AND SHALL REPORT THE BUSINESS OF SUCH MEETINGS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE 3 ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

1 a) NOT LATER THAN ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL MEETING, THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT A NOMINATING COMMITTEE CONSISTING OF NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THE USER'S GROUP AND SHALL DESIGNATE ONE MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE AS CHAIRMAN.

1 b) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL, BEFORE THE ANNUAL MEETING, CONVENE A MEETING OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE TO CONSIDER NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

1 c) TO ASSIST THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE IN SELECTING CANDIDATES, A QUESTIONNAIRE EXPLAINING THE FUNCTION OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE AND INVITING THE MEMBERS TO INDICATE, BY MEANS OF THE SAME QUESTIONNAIRE, THE NAMES OF MEMBERS THAT THEY CONSIDER WORTHY OF NOMINATION. THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO NOMINATE ANY PERSONS THUS INDICATED EXCEPT WHERE AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL HAVE BEEN INDICATED BY TEN PER CENT (10%) OF THE ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP.

1 d) HAVING GIVEN DUE REGARD TO THE INDICATIONS RECEIVED VIA THE QUESTIONNAIRES, THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL PRESENT A LIST OF NOMINATIONS TO THE MEMBERS AT THE ANNUAL MEETING.

2) MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING MAY BE NOMINATED FROM THE FLOOR DURING THE ANNUAL MEETING. SUCH NOMINATIONS MUST BE SPONSORED BY NOT LESS THAN TWO (2) MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING.

3) VOTING SHALL TAKE PLACE, BY MEANS OF SECRET BALLOT, AT THE ANNUAL MEETING. THOSE NOMINEES RECEIVING THE GREATEST NUMBER OF VOTES FROM THOSE CAST BY THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING EITHER PRESENT IN PERSON OR REPRESENTED BY PROXY SHALL BE CONSIDERED THE WINNERS AND SHALL BE INSTALLED AT THE FOLLOWING GENERAL MEETING.

4) IN THE CASE OF THE RESIGNATION OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER, OR A VACANCY IN ANY EXECUTIVE OFFICE, THE PRESIDENT SHALL BE EMPOWERED TO APPOINT ANY SUCH MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING TO FILL THE VACANCY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM.

ARTICLE 4 MEMBERSHIP

1) PROPOSALS OR APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE APPROPRIATE DUES.

2) THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP PERIOD SHALL COINCIDE WITH THE CALENDAR YEAR.

3 a) ANNUAL DUES FOR RENEWAL MEMBERSHIPS SHALL BE DUE AT OR BY THE ANNUAL MEETING.

3 b) MEMBERS SHALL BE SUSPENDED WHEN DUES ARE ONE (1) MONTH OR MORE IN ARREARS AND MAY, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, BE DROPPED FROM THE MEMBERSHIP.

ARTICLE 5 LIABILITY OF MEMBERS

1) NO MEMBER, INCLUDING OFFICERS, SHALL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE OR RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY BILLS OR OBLIGATIONS OF THE USER'S GROUP, PAST OR PRESENT, EXCEPT FOR THE PAYMENT OF PERSONAL MEMBERSHIP DUES OR WHERE SUCH BILLS OR OBLIGATIONS HAVE BEEN INCURRED WITHOUT DUE PROCESS AND AUTHORIZATION BY THAT MEMBER.

2) NO MEMBER, INCLUDING OFFICERS, SHALL DISBURSE OR DISPOSE OF ANY FUNDS, MONEYS OR PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE USER'S GROUP WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION, CONFIRMED IN WRITING, FROM THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

3) NO PERSON SHALL USE THE NAME OR MAILING LIST OF THE USER'S GROUP FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN THOSE PURPOSES WHICH ARE STRICTLY THOSE OF THE USER'S GROUP WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION, CONFIRMED IN WRITING, FROM THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

4) NO MEMBER MAY PRESENT HIMSELF AS SPEAKING FOR OR EXPRESSING AN OPINION ON BEHALF OF THE USER'S GROUP WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION, CONFIRMED IN WRITING, FROM THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE 6 UNSPECIFIED PROCEDURES

1) ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER SHALL GOVERN IN ALL MATTERS NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED BY OR DEALT WITH IN THE CONSTITUTION AND/OR OPERATING PROCEDURES.

ARTICLE 7 AMENDMENTS

1) THESE OPERATING PROCEDURES MAY BE AMENDED BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE ACTIVE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING WHO ARE PRESENT IN PERSON OR REPRESENTED BY PROXY AT ANY REGULAR MEETING, BUT NO AMENDMENT SHALL BE VOTED UPON WITHOUT TWO (2) WEEKS WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING.
