Trivia..What does a program that combines music and a data base do? Hint: I call it the Lone Ranger.

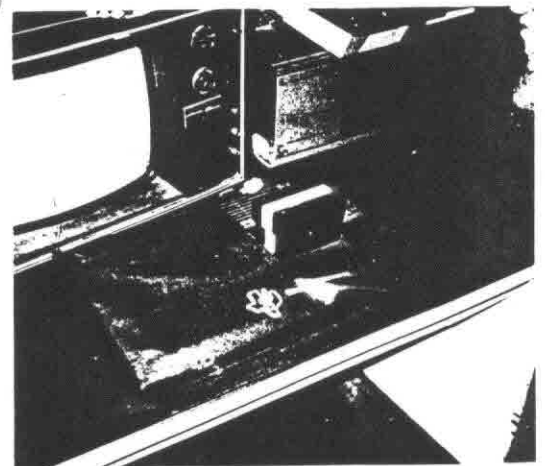

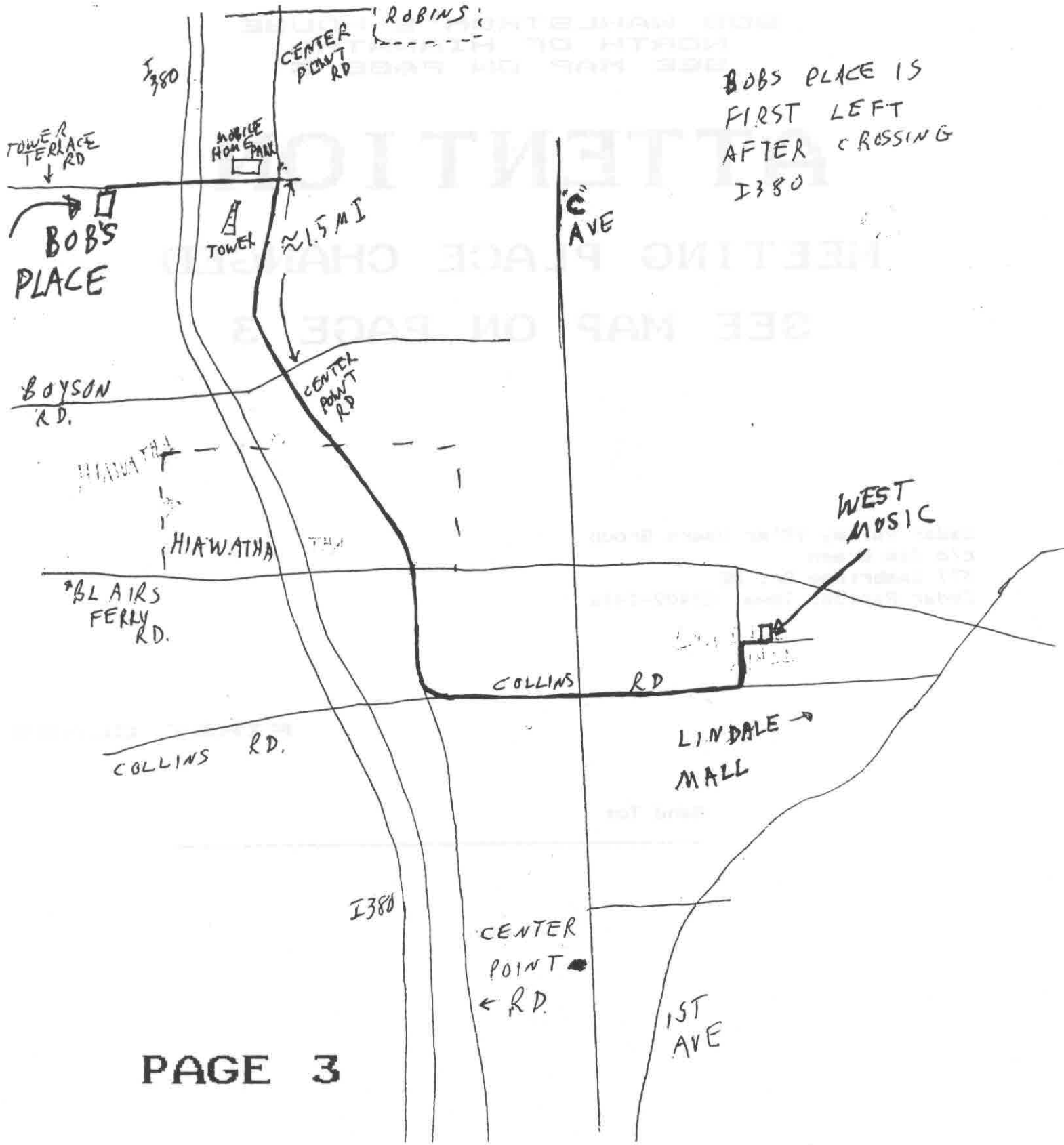
Newsletter..At the risk of repeating myself I wish to congratulate Jeff on the Newsletter. Looks great!
