Unfortunately, most of these prograns have not been readily available to most of the 11 users. Only a fem of the user groups have really large public domain libraries, and even these are usually cataloged only by alphabetized abbreviated filenames. The more isolated users have even less access.

I have therefore decided to make the contents of my public domain library avallable to the II norld, at a copying fee so lon that I hope no one will think I an unfairly profiting from the work of others land I think you will note, in the following listings, that I have probably contributed more to the public donain than anyone else!!, but if any author objects to my distributing his work I will certainly stop. My catalog contains the author's name for each progran, when available, both in order to give due credit and to aid in distinguishing betmeen programs of the sdme nane. Regrettably, many of the IUG programs distributed by Annion have had the author's name deleted.

Falrmarg authors say reasonably object to anyone charging to distribute their work. I will lherefore not offer any falrware unless 1 receive the author's express pernission. I will not offer anything which bears a copyright notice unless I have definite information that the copyright has been abandoned or was not intended to preclude distribution. It is entirely possible that $I$ nay have obtained programs from which a copyright or fairnare notice had been deleted, and 1 would appreciate being informed of any such in my catalog.

I have gone through ay library of over 4000 public domain prograns and seiected enough of the better ones to fill over 400 disks, arranged by category. Each 9S/SD disk contains as many programs as I could fit onto it, if I had enough prograns of that category the number of filled sectors on each disk is indicated in parentheses. All Basic-only prograns have been converted to pun in Extended Basic lexcept those which use the TEll speech), and an XBasic loader has been provided for assembly programs whenever possible. Each disk has been provided with an autoloader by full progran name, not filenane.

1 have added instructions to a good many of these programs, and corrected any bugs that I noticed, but I cannot guarantee then in any may, and cannot offer to provide instructions, correct bugs or make modifications. I will of course replace any bad loads, and mould
appreciate being informed of any program which has serious flaws.

This public domain is offered only as a copying service, not as a sale of computer software, and I take no responsibility other than providing a copy equal to the original. Contents of all disks are subject to change without notice.
