A T.I. SURPRISE

On November 10th the T.I. S.U.N.N. Users Group got two (2) disks from T.I. Both disks contain Programs to diagnose your computer, disk drive(s), Printer(s) RS232s and memory expansion. I used the Extended Basic diagnostic disk and my equipment checked out: "GOOD UNIT". The disks came with extensive documentation and some nice advertisements about T.I. calculators. I have also gotten two (2) catalogs from TRITON tm. With great bargains on EXTENDED BASIC (\$29.95) and a SPEECH SYNTHASISER (\$29.95).

Now back to the diagnostics from T.I. The Programs on the disks include:

- 3) Load (loads main menu)

The disks are accessed by using menus from the disk. The loading and operation of the Programs are fully covered in the documentation so I will not reproduce it here.

You may copy the disks for your own files. You may photocopy the instructions and the advertisements. If you wish to order any of the Products in the Package you do not have to go through the club to do so. Make a copy of the order forms and remit the Payment directly to the company.

It seems to be a good Package of information and it will put many Peoples mind to rest on the condition of their computers.

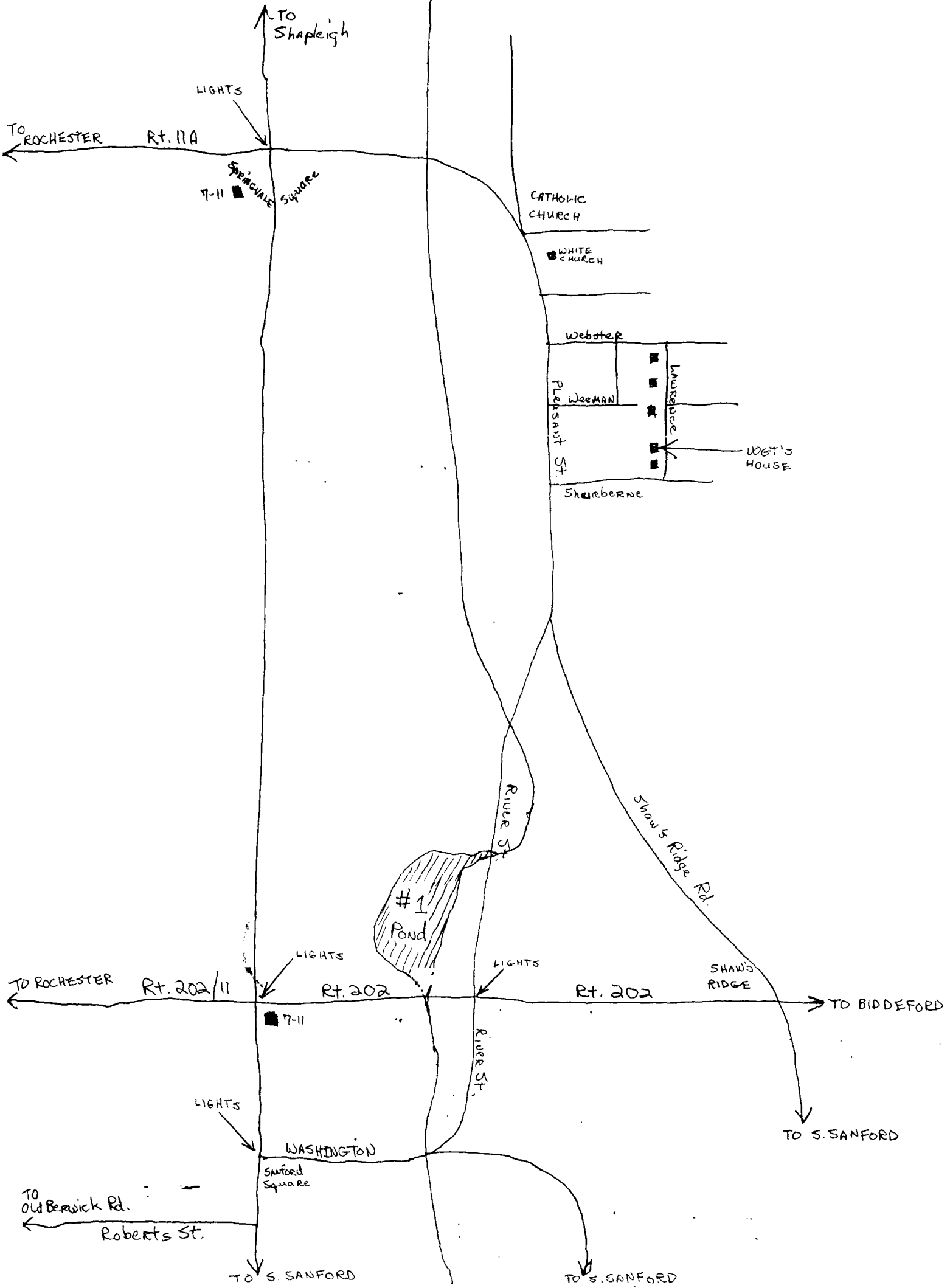

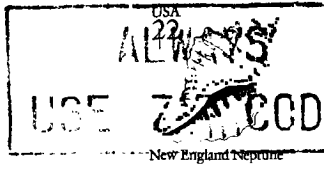
