

TISHUG (Australia) Limited

Minutes of Annual General Meeting, held Saturday 6 February, 1988 at the Burwood RSL Club Limited, 96 Shaftsbury Road, Burwood, NSW.

1. Opening:

THUG

Chairman Chris Buttner opened the meeting at 1.35pm and welcomed those members present. A list of members present is shown with names highlighted on the attached membership lists.

2. Apologies:

Apologies were recorded and accepted from :

Rav Brown Arto Heino George Meldrum

3. Reading and confirmation of Minutes:

Chris Buttner explained that despite repeated attempts, minutes of Agenda items 1 to 11 had not been obtained from Brian Graham, who was in the chair at the time at the 1987 AGM. The only minutes available were those for Agenda items 12 to 14 as published in the January/February edition of the TND.

4. Correspondence and dealing with same:

Letter from Geoff Trott to Editor TND was to be read from chair to meeting, however Geoff Trott advised he had made copies and had distributed same to members. Chairman advised would allow 5 minutes for members to read letter.

Discussion on G Trott letter. Speakers were:

Geoff Trott - advised he was not here when incorporation changes made. Comments in his letter based on his reading of TNDs on return and general comments he had heard. His concerns were the membership attrition rate and his feelings that members were only allowed a say at the AGM and that there was a lack of information for country members. He was also disturbed at the Directors' decision to direct the Editor not to publish his letter.

Ben Von Takach - agreed generally with the tenor of the letter. However did not see the AGM as only place where members had a say. Problems he had encountered in the past had been straightened out with an appropriate phone call as Directors always available to help as needed.

Tom Marshall - felt that final responsibility for publishing items in TND should rest with the Editor.

Chris Buttner - responded to the queries raised by stating that the Directors are responsible to the members plus the CAC. Any member feeling aggrieved has the option to discuss such grievance with the Directors. Options are available under the conditions set out in the Articles of Association for a member to take things further if he feels he has a genuine grievance.

Furthermore, monthly Directors meetings are not a

closed shop and any member is welcome to be present. In so far as content of TND, local or overseas this was something members should think about and let the new Directors know.

5. Reading and dealing with recommendations from the Board:

Chris Buttner apologised for the lateness of mailing of the Directors and Financial Reports.

As in the report, it was proposed that 3 former life members of TIsHUG, Shane Andersen, John Robinson Life members of TISHUG, Shane Andersen, John Kobinson and Terry Phillips be re-confirmed as honorary life members of TISHUG (Australia) Ltd. Geoff Trott re-proposed that to comply with the Articles of Association such honorary life membership should be granted from the date of incorporation. This re-proposal was seconded by Gerry Lee and carried on a show of hands.

6. Directors reports, presentation of Accounts and Auditors reports:

Chris Buttner asked if there were any queries on the previously mailed reports.

Stephen Carr - queried there were no signatures on his copies. Chris Buttner advised they had been signed by the auditor and members were free to examine copies held at the chair.

Geoff Trott - queried the amount of depreciation. Chris Buttner advised that this was explained in the notes to final accounts which were also available for perusal at the chair.

Geoff Trott - queried the unsecured loan. Chris Buttner advised this was for Incorporation expenses the difference being shown as Intangibles.

Geoff Trott - queried cash advances and Bob Montgomery's not listed. Bert Thomas advised he had asked Bob Montgomery for details but had not been advised. Chris Buttner advised that it would still be in the books and auditor would have looked at.

Geoff Trott - asked what the costs charged to freight represented. Chris Buttner advised this represented costs associated with importation of MICROpendium.

Geoff Trott - felt that each unit of operation should be shown as a separate entity to show what is costing what. Chris Buttner advised that the auditor wished to speak to the new treasurer and that this departmental type accounting would probably be discussed.

7. Unfinished business from last AGM (if any):

Nil.

8. Election of Returning Officer and two Scrutineers:

The following were elected -

Returning Officer - Ross Mudie, nominated by Russell Welham, seconded Stephen Carr.

Deputy Returning Officer - Stephen Carr, nominated by Cyril Bohlsen, seconded Percy Harrison.

Scrutineers - John Paine and Percy Harrison.

9. Election of Directors:

Chris Buttner advised that at closure of nominations only four had been received. Therefore further nominations could be made at the meeting. John Paine further pointed out that those nominees received at closure were not necessarily elected. All nominees go into ballot.

Chris Buttner retired from the chair and Ross Mudie took over as Chairman. Before retiring, Chris made a donation to Ross for his software contributions.

Tom Marshall suggested a vote of thanks at this time for retiring Directors and Committeemen. This was done by acclamation.

After some confusion with nominations an adjournment was had for 5 minutes to enable all nominees to hand in the nomination forms. continued on page 14

Report on Alternate Micro Show Aston (near Birmingham) 12th November 1988 from Stephen Shaw, England

RHUG

This show, held at the Aston Sports Centre, not far from Birmingham and easily reached by rail and motorway, was organised by Emsoft, software publishers for the Tatung Einstein computer.

They had organised the Show for users of the Einstein, and in a gesture of solidarity, invited User Groups and Dealers connected with other orphan computers to participate. Orphan computers do not have any coverage in magazines or other shows! Naturally, many of the 47 stands were connected with the Einstein computer, also many were generic, dealing with general computer supplies suitable for any computer, disks and paper and so on.

It was entirely appropriate for the TI99/4A to be represented, as the monitor supplied for the Tatung Einstein is the only monitor that can be connected directly to the PAL TI99/4A, which has an unusual colour difference video output.

The TI99/4A was represented by stands from TI99/4A Users Group (UK), by the East Anglia Region User Group, and by lone UK dealer Parco Electric. Parco had a good selection of modules available. The TI99/4A Users Group had a nice little robot, controlled by joystick, who was most polite and apologised nicely if he bumped into anything. His core program came from Ross Mudie and appeared in the September 1987 newsletter of the Sydney User Group (Australia).

Other micros represented were the MSX series, the Sinclair QL, the Lynx, the Enterprise (brain child of David Levy who had a hand in the TI99/4A Video Chess module), and the little Jupiter Ace, the only home computer to be sold with a language other than Basic on board; Forth 79. There was no User Group representation for the New Brain or the Memotech or the Dragon. Many users and some dealers changed to the UK produced Dragon after dropping the TI99/4A.

One stand was taken by a general supplier who purchased odd orphan products, and TIUG was able to purchase a box of assorted modules at not a lot more than a couple of pounds each, including a five pack of the Adventure module.

The show was well attended and had good refreshment facilities, but never became too crowded. The TI99/4A owning visitors seemed to have mostly heard of the show from their own groups. The hoped for swelling of membership as a result of the national publicity said to be provided by the organisers was not seen. Nevertheless, it was a rare meeting together of TI99/4A users, some of whom travelled very long distances indeed.

The organisers have booked the Bingley Hall, three miles from Stafford, for a two day show in 1989. Your reporter is not at all certain that the orphan groups and dealers can maintain a two day show, and the location is not known for its national shows (three miles from the nearest railway station and with bus services liable to cancellation instantly is not so good), and moving the show nearer the North (away from the more populous South East) is not usually a good thing for exhibitions. We shall see what happens next year!
