CALL WAITING

If you have the call-waiting feature on the phone line, you get disconnected from a board when a call comes in. While a disconnect does no harm to a board, A lot of Sysops have become annoyed when they to respond to a system alarm, take the system down, and check it in case something may have gone wrong. This deprives others of access while they have to stop whatever they are doing to check the system.

TO TURN OFF CALL WAITING TEMPORARILY,

All you have to do is dial** 70 from a touchtone phone, or just 70 from a rotary dial phone. Then you wait 5 seconds and then you dial the BBS number. In some areas, the code to dial may vary. Call your local telephone business office if the code above doesn't work on your phone. Call-waiting will automatically start again when you finish your call. If you have a Dialing directory in your term program, you can set up your dialing macro to do it for you automatically.

ATDI* 70,,,???????

The above is for tone dialing. Delete the * for rotary dialout. The three commas provide the necessary delay for call-waiting drop before dialing the number on the second dialtone.
