
UNDER CONSTRUCTION



Frank plans on retiring from the TI Community at the end of this year.


Frank, you're really going to be missed. Any chance of talking you into coming to the meetings, just to socialize with your TI buddies?

Our exchange newsletters are still coming in, although not quite as many as years gone by.



My deepest appreciation to Paul Brock for showing me how to use Page Pro 99.







